APPOINTMENT AND PROCEDURE POLICY

1.
 - 1.1. Please do not bring any children to the appointment. Accompanying adult guest is allowed but will be asked to remain waiting in the reception room during the time of your procedure. This is in conjunction with Board of Health regulation and must be followed.
2. Covid-19 Vaccination Policy - Based on available information regarding Covid-19 vaccinations, the Best Practices Committee's Medical experts follow the current guidance used in associated medical practices. Permanent cosmetic professionals should refrain from conducting procedures **Two Weeks before or after a Covid-19 vaccination and/or Booster** if choosing to follow this guidance. There may be delayed reactions to the vaccines, and it may be difficult to discern an untoward response to products used during the permanent cosmetic procedure. There is also a consideration to separate any inflammatory responses either may cause.
3. The time of appointment is reserved exclusively for the client. To reserve an appointment for a procedure a 20% deposit of the total service price is required. The deposit will be applied to the balance due at your Initial Session cost of the procedure. The final balance due will be collected at your Perfection Session. If an appointment needs to be rescheduled; 48 hour notice is required in order to fill the appointment. The First Time an appointment is rescheduled, the deposit will then be applied to the rescheduled appointment. If you fail to give notice within 48 hours, have to reschedule a second time, fail to reschedule, fail to show up to your appointment you will forfeit your deposit and it will not be refunded or applied

to a new appointment. The full price of the procedure will be due with another 20% procedure deposit for a new appointment. Deposits will not be refunded for: Cancellations made less than 48 hours in advance, "No shows", The same day cancellations. Please understand that time is reserved for you and I need sufficient notice to fill my schedule.

4. For New Clients who have Never had permanent make up/ cosmetic tattooing on area being treated, the following applies. The first visit is the Initial session; this visit accomplishes the basic design and color saturation. A minimum of 5 weeks later is the Perfection Session; this visit focuses on balance of color saturation and design details of the healed result.
5. ColorBoost Appointment for Clients who had their permanent make up/ cosmetic tattooing originally performed by Lisa DeLaurentis will be done 1-2 years post procedure. This is Not for clients who have had work done previously by other artists. Your permanent makeup needs to be considered LOW maintenance not NO maintenance. The longer you go in between color boosts, the more work it is and sometimes will require a complete re-draw of the brows, just like on your very first appointment reflecting a New Procedure Cost. To save money, it is recommended to come in within 2 years to keep your permanent makeup fresh and precise. There is a set ColorBoost fee for 6-9 months post procedure and another for 12-24 months post procedure.
6. Permanent Make Up/ Cosmetic Tattooing done by another artist. Recoloring of permanent makeup done previously by any other technician is not a "touch-up" or "ColorBoost" procedure since it is not original work by Lisa DeLaurentis. Such works are called "cover-up" procedures. The fees for "cover-up" procedures are referred to as New procedures and/or Color Correction procedures and charged accordingly. Some but not all procedures can be achieved in the two sessions included in New Procedure Pricing. Depending on the current condition of the current area and the desired outcome of the procedure a Color Correction Session requiring a separate fee may be necessary in addition to the New Procedure Cost. Or it may be determined that Tattoo Removal will be necessary in order to achieve this outcome reflecting a separate fee in addition to the New Procedure Cost. Photos previous to booking will be required and this will be discussed at the time you consult with Lisa DeLaurentis. Its final determination will be at your first in person appointment.

7. Due to the skin and it being a living, ever evolving organ that is exposed to the elements or outside influences beyond Lisa's control, an additional Perfection Session along with an additional fee may be required to achieve the desired final result. All procedure Aftercare is reviewed in detail, All opportunity to tweak and finalize the design is given and All questions are answered at the close of your session. If you do not follow the Aftercare instructions, decide to change or add to the design of the procedure in any way an additional Perfection Session fee will apply. If the client does not follow the instruction of correct healing and aftercare no claims will be accepted by technician. If the loss of pigment is a result of picking or bly removing scabs, causing loss of pigment, any repeat procedure resulting will be at the cost of the client. There are No Free Sessions.

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
